

Roundtable on Empirical Methods in Intellectual Property

The Roundtable on Empirical Methods in Intellectual Property, hosted annually by Northwestern Pritzker School of Law, Cardozo Law School and the United States Patent & Trademark Office, is intended to give scholars engaging in empirical and experimental studies of IP a chance to receive feedback on their work at an early stage in their research. Accordingly, the roundtable is limited to a small cohort of scholars discussing projects that are still in their developmental stages. Projects that will have substantially begun data collection by the time of the roundtable are inappropriate. Pilot data collection is, however, appropriate.
