Distance Education Policy:

*All online classes will be considered distance education courses for the purposes of sitting for the bar. Please ensure you will not take more than the allotted distance education credits allowed for your given jurisdiction before electing to take these courses.

The New York Court of Appeals limits the number of credits that students who wish to be admitted to practice in NY can take via "distance education." Any Cardozo course that is offered in an all-remote format counts as a "distance education" course. JD Students can take no more than 15 credits in courses offered solely in a remote format. Students are responsible for keeping track of how many such credits they earn and abiding by the 15-credit limitation if they wish to take the New York bar exam. Please note that other states' requirements may differ and students should make sure to abide by any limitations imposed by states in which they may seek admission to practice.
