TIPS FOR TABLE TALK STYLE NETWORKING

Plan out which employers you want to focus on most and have a few talking points or questions ready.

Do some research. At this stage, you don't need to know everything you would know at an interview, but it is helpful to understand the main work an employer does so you can focus the on more substantive information.

Arrive on time and be flexible. If your preferred employer's table is full, use your time productively, and join another table to make other connections in the interim. You never know which employer will be a surprise fit!
